On November 13th, 2017, the Transportation Policy Board approved Fiscal Year 2017 funding for the FTA Section 5310: Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities program. City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department was awarded \$49,368.00 in other funding.

The Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Capital Metro) serves as the designated recipient for FTA Section 5310 Funds in the Austin Urbanized Area. Project sponsors will enter into a grant agreement with Capital Metro and will become subrecipients for these funds. The grant agreement will detail additional requirements related to project administration and reporting and may specify deadlines for expenditure of the funds to ensure that timely progress is made.
