

**ORDINANCE NO.**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20171214-019 RELATING TO SPECIALIZED FUNCTIONS, CERTIFICATIONS, ASSIGNMENTS, AND ADDITIONAL PAY, AND AUTHORIZING VACATION ACCUMULATION LEAVE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL EMPLOYED BY THE AUSTIN-TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** Part 7 of Ordinance No. 20171214-019 is amended to read as follows:

This ordinance will automatically expire without further action required by Council upon the effective date of a new meet and confer agreement between the City and the Austin-Travis County EMS Employees Association, or on March 30, 2018, whichever event occurs first.

**PART 2.** Except as provided in this ordinance, Ordinance No. 20171214-019 shall remain in effect as originally approved.

**PART 3.** The Council finds that the potential lapse of additional pay and other elements in Ordinance No. 20171214-019 while the City and the Austin-Travis County EMS Employees Association are actively engaged in bargaining constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
