Council Committee, Boards and Commission Action	The Austin Travis County EMS Advisory Board reviewed this agenda item on November 1, 2017 and a five-year franchise was approved for recommendation on a motion of 7-0.

Additional Backup Information:

This is to request that Council hold a public hearing regarding the application of a non-emergency transfer franchise requested by Allegiance Mobile Health (“Allegiance”) and approve the franchise agreement on first reading.

Allegiance applied for a non-emergency transfer franchise with the City of Austin in September 2017 and is requesting a five-year term.

In order for a private ambulance company to provide non-emergency transfer services within the limits of the City of Austin, the provider must hold a franchise from the City. Non-emergency transfers typically occur between skilled nursing facilities, hospitals, and private residences and are usually prescheduled by medical personnel. Currently, two companies hold non-emergency transfer franchises in Austin; American Medical Response of Texas, Inc. (AMR), and Acadian Ambulance Services of Texas, LLC. (Acadian).

The Austin-Travis County EMS Advisory Board reviewed the staff findings on November 1, 2017, and recommended Allegiance for a five year franchise in a vote of 7-0. The Board Recommendation is attached, along with a memo outlining staff findings.
