a. Tenant Relocation. Discuss and consider amending Title 25 of the City Code, related to tenant relocation regulations. Sponsor: Commissioner Greenberg; Co-Sponsor: Commissioner Denkler. Discussion and/or possible action.

Commissioners Greenberg and Denkler explained a need for a potential code change that was highlighted by a recent zoning case: renters in a manufactured home park moved out after leases ended, and when the property applied for rezoning, the residents were already gone (ie there was no way to give them relocation assistance). Commission discussed the possibility of extending the time frame during which relocation assistance must be given, but staff from NHCD indicated that it might not be possible. Staff agreed to meet with the Law department to

determine if any further steps could be taken or changes to the code made to address the Commissioners' concerns. After consulting with the Law Department, this item will likely come back on a future agenda.
