

BOARD/COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

Human Rights Commission

Recommendation Number: 20180226-5b Addressing Race and Gender Equity in City Policy of Naming Streets, Public Buildings, Statues, Memorials, Public Parks, Park Facilities, and Features.

WHEREAS, the Human Rights Commission of the City of Austin ("Commission") advocates on behalf of human rights for all people in the City of Austin ("City"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission's duties include, but are not limited to, advising and consulting with the Austin City Council ("Council") as well as all City departments, advisory boards and regulatory agencies on all matters involving discrimination, including providing legislative recommendations and proposing measures to improve the ability of various departments and agencies, as well as initiating and facilitating discussions and negotiations between individuals and groups to lessen tensions and improve understanding in the community and aiding in the formulation of local community groups in neighborhoods as needed to carry out specific programs; and

WHEREAS on October 23, 2017 the Commission approved Recommendation No. 201701023-001b (Women's Equity in Austin Equity in Naming of Public Symbols) addressing Race and Gender Equity in City Policy of naming streets, public buildings, statues, memorials, public parks, park facilities, and features; in which, the Commission proposed that the Council and the City Manager's Office take all appropriate steps to immediately insert, in those criteria used by the City to select names for streets, public buildings, statues, memorials, public parks, park facilities, and features, a requirement that going forward, gender and racial equity shall be required, meaning that, for any new streets, public buildings, statues, memorials, public parks, park facilities and features, names after natural persons, that half of them shall be named after women and at least half of these shall be named after women of color; and

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2017, a representative from the City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department ("PARD") appeared and briefed the Commission on the issue of gender and the naming of parks and park features; and

WHEREAS, that PARD representative, Gregory Montes, subsequently provided a document (Exhibit A) showing that, of 106 officially named parks, 14 (13.2%) are named after

women, 37 (34.9%) are named after men, 49 (46.2%) are named after location, and 6 (5.7%) are named after families; and

WHEREAS on November 27, 2017, the Commission gathered more information regarding the naming criteria used by PARD during which time it became clear that the process for naming of PARD spaces can either be decided by Council vote or proposed by a community member through an application process, and

WHEREAS on November 27, 2017, the Commission gathered more information about the process of requesting a gender analysis of street names in the city of Austin to evaluate the existing percentage of streets named after men versus women,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council and the City Manager's Office take all appropriate steps toward rectifying the gender imbalance in naming of PARD spaces, including but not limited to, soliciting input from relevant communities and voting to modify the names of 23 existing parks with location-based names to include the names of notable women and that half of these names are notable women of color (e.g. Bessie Coleman Park at Alamo Street in lieu of Alamo Pocket Park) so that PARD has 37 parks named after women to match the 37 parks named after men; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council and the City Manager's Office confer with staff within the Address Management Services Team of the Communications and Technology Management Department, in order to purchase NamSor software at an anticipated cost of approximately \$45-99, and thereafter process the 15,650 unique names in the City's Street Name Database and conduct a gender analysis of those names as a first step toward identifying and rectifying gender imbalance in street naming; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, after equitable proactive policies have been put in place, Council may again call upon the Human Rights Commission to offer recommendations in connection with studying the extent of naming inequities and remedial measures to address them.
