

**RESOLUTION NO. 20180322-093**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing to consider the permanent and temporary use of parkland for the construction, use, maintenance, repair, and replacement of a permanent wastewater line in connection with the Southland Oaks Waste Water Improvements Project, through Bauerle Ranch at the Slaughter Creek Greenbelt (the "Proposed Use"); and

**WHEREAS**, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described on Exhibit A (the "Affected Land"); and


**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearing to be held on March 22, 2018 was given for three consecutive weeks on February 25, March 4, and March 11, 2018 in a newspaper of general circulation; and

**WHEREAS**, such public hearing was held March 22, 2018, by the City Council to consider the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, the City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.
