#### 1. CITIZEN COMMUNICATION: GENERAL

- Josiah Stevenson spoke in support of lower design speeds on corridors, dedicated right of way for transit on Guadalupe near the UT Austin campus, prioritization of improvements to bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure that connect to existing transit, and the use of NACTO standards. Spoke against the use of bus pull-outs.
- Heyden Walker encouraged meeting attendees to participate in the City's Vision Zero Program's <u>yard sign pilot program</u>.

# A. Proposed Corridor Construction Program – Briefing and Possible Action

Mike Trimble, Corridor Program Office (CPO) Director, briefed PAC members on the <u>Proposed Corridor Construction</u> <u>Program</u>. Keith Taylor, Transportation Engineer at the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), was also present to answer questions.

Following the presentation, PAC and BAC members worked together to draft recommendation language regarding the Proposed Corridor Construction Program.

**Action taken**: After debate and amendment, recommendations were adopted by both the PAC and the BAC concurrently.

The PAC adopted the recommendations on Walker motion, Crossley second on a 6-0 vote with Deolloz, Haithcock and Kinney absent.

The BAC adopted the recommendations on Heinen motion, Schaub second on a 5-0 vote with Louviere-Ligons, Alcorn, Eden, and Lentz absent and Wald appointed to vote in Flowers' place for the purposes of the meeting
