Request: Variance request is as follows:

1. Construction on slopes in excess of 15% (LDC 25-8-302)

2. Cut over 4 feet (LDC 25-8-341)

3. Fill over 4 feet (LDC 25-8-342)

Staff Determination: Staff recommends approval for the variances needed to gain access to the property and cut for the pond, with conditions. Staff does not recommend approval for the variances needed to build the proposed driveway for future development, to construct the parking lot, or cut outside the pond footprint.

Reason for Determination: Access and pond: Findings of fact have been met.

Driveway, parking lot, and area outside of pond: Findings of fact have not been met.
