#### I. Part B Grants Administration/Management Update

- BVCOG is updating our eligibility policy to be in line with City of Austin and DSHS. DSHS will have something out in the next couple of weeks for public comment.
- RWB FY19 allocations have been sent out to providers. Contracts are to be sent out March 1.
- HOPWA contracts have been sent out to providers, and are executed.
- BVCOG has switched over to using DocuSign for contracts, initially just with HOPWA, and will begin to use for contract amendments.
- RWHAP Eligibility Training will be held via webinar on March 14

#### **II. Part B Expenditure Summary Update**

The FY18 Part B expenditure summary is shown in Table 1 below. Eighty-three (83%) percent of the year has expired; however, seventy-eight (78%) percent of funds have been through January 2018. For supplemental funding, Eighty-three (83%) of the year has expired; however, seventy-six (76%) percent of funds have been expended through January 2018.
