BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Council directs the City Manager to, within six months, construct, build or establish, either through temporary structure or other alternative arrangement, interim fire stations in at least the top two areas of greatest need as identified in the 2017 Austin Fire Department/Austin Fire Association Fire Station Risk and Service Delivery Analysis Report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Council directs the City Manager to either include funds to staff the interim fire stations in the City Manager's recommended fiscal year 2018-2019 budget for Council consideration, or prepare any necessary funding requests during the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget adoption process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Council directs the City Manager to develop a six-year timeline to fund, construct, and staff five permanent fire stations in the areas of greatest need as identified in thean updated 2017 Austin Fire Department/Austin Fire Association Fire Station Risk and Service Delivery Analysis Report, that accounts for recent CAMPO funding allocated to Advanced Signal Timing technology, as well as projected mobility improvements from the 2016 City of Austin Mobility Bond.
