INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT

- Stephen F. Austin Drive is a privately owned street by AISD (Cesar Chavez to Veterans Drive)
- Request from AISD to partner with Austin Transportation
- Amend current ILA to include meter installation, maintenance and enforcement of parking regulations
- All meter funds collected, less city expenses, are given to AISD

A consistent on-street parking system that will reduce public confusion by providing continuity of service and enhances the overall mobility system within the area and city.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS


Increased parking pressure from paid parking on Stephen F Austin Drive will push parkers to the free parking space on Veterans & Atlanta Drives, parking lots, and surrounding streets.

- Low Turn Over
- Increased Congestion
- Decreased Mobility

PTMD OVERVIEW

- Ordinance 12-7. Parking and Transportation Management Districts.
- Minimum 100 new on-street or 200 paid public off-street spaces
- 51% of funds, less city expenses, from paid public parking within the district is used for projects that confer public benefits within the district.
- Parking Coordination with district committee and ATD Staff
- Monitoring/Enforcement of parking regulations












COLORADO RIVER AREA OVERALL PARKING MANAGEMENT PLAN

PARKING MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR OFF-STREET PARKING LOTS

City Lot: PARD Tennis Court lot (100 parking spaces)


- Current agreement between AISD and PARD for Austin High School to use parking lot for student parking Monday – Friday 8am to 5pm.
- No meters will be installed in parking lot.

State Parking Lot: Underneath MOPAC (200 parking spaces)

- Metering
- MUA amendment with TxDot to allow for funds generated in lot to be used on projects along the MOPAC corridor, from Hwy 360 to West 35th Street.
- Projects may include:
 - Lighting Infrastructure
 - Repaying of parking lots
