Set a public hearing to consider the Austin Downtown Public Improvement District 2019 assessments. (Suggested date and time: August 9, 2018, 4:00 p.m. at Austin City Hall, 301 W. Second Street, Austin TX). Related to Item # 18-2116.

Fiscal Note	The 2019 assessment rate of \$0.10/\$100 valuation is estimated to produce \$8,817,067.11 at a 96% collection rate. A fiscal note is not required.

This action would set the public hearing on the Austin Downtown Public Improvement District

(PID) 2019 certified assessment for August 9, 2018. The proposed 2019 assessment rate of \$0.10/\$100 valuation is estimated to produce \$8,817,067 at a 96% collection rate. The estimate of \$8,817,067 is the preliminary assessment value for the PID as of April 30, 2018. This total is subject to change with the certified assessment value available after August 1, 2018. Assessments on real property fund the PID services.

State law requires a public hearing by Council to consider the proposed 2019 assessments. Approval of the assessment rate and proposed assessment roll on June 28, 2018, allows notices to be sent to property owners, giving them an opportunity to review the property valuations prior to the public hearing. Property owners have a right to challenge their assessment at the hearing. At the hearing, the Council must hear and pass on any objection, made orally or in writing, to any proposed assessment, prior to approval of the ordinance levying assessments and setting the method of collection and the rate of interest for late payments.

The City Council will consider the approval of the Austin Downtown PID 2019-2020 Service and Assessment Plan and Budget update with certified assessment values on August 9, 2018.
