



**AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES**

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
TUESDAY, MAY 29, 2018**

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Special Called meeting on Tuesday, May 29, 2018, City Hall, 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Adler called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m. Council Members Flannigan and Troxclair were absent.

1. Conduct a public hearing regarding adoption of a comprehensive revision to the Land Development Code, commonly referred to as “CodeNEXT,” relating to the regulation of land use and development in the City of Austin and its extraterritorial jurisdiction, together with related actions and City Code amendments.

Mayor Adler recessed the meeting at 12:28 p.m. without objection.

Mayor Adler reconvened the meeting at 1:42 p.m. without objection.

1. Conduct a public hearing regarding adoption of a comprehensive revision to the Land Development Code, commonly referred to as “CodeNEXT,” relating to the regulation of land use and development in the City of Austin and its extraterritorial jurisdiction, together with related actions and City Code amendments. **(CONTINUED)**

Mayor Adler recessed the meeting at 2:27 p.m. without objection.

Mayor Adler reconvened the meeting at 4:11 p.m. without objection.
