










The 1935 Sanborn map shows tire sales and service on the current site. A. Bryan Spires opened Tire Service Company at 301-03 W. 5th Street in 1928; it became the Firestone Service Store by 1930 and remained so until the mid-1940s.





The 1961 Sanborn map shows a photo engraving business in the building; Thompson Photo Engraving is listed in city directories in the 1960s at this address.



Building permit to Mrs. Ben F. Marshall to enclose the filling station which had been on the corner of 5^{th} and Lavaca; this permit likely had no effect on the building at 303 W. 5^{th} Street.
