Authorize award and execution of a contract with Government Scientific Source Inc., to provide a spectrometer with accessories and services, in an amount not to exceed \$100,402. (Note: This solicitation was reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2-9D Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program. For the goods and services required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established).

Of the three offers received, the recommended contractor submitted the only responsive offer. The contract will provide Austin Energy with a new spectrometer to meet regulatory requirements for soil and water analysis and to maintain plant machinery by evaluating wear on metal parts. The instrument currently in use is 10 years old. Repair parts are no longer available and it is no longer supported by the manufacturer.
