The contract is for the purchase of high-definition cameras and recording equipment for use in interview rooms located throughout Austin Police Department campuses and substations. The contract will provide installation, equipment, maintenance, support, licenses, and data storage. As part of the installation, the Contractor will provide data and cloud management services through the Evidence.com platform. Recorded footage will automatically upload to the Evidence.com platform where the data will be securely stored, managed and retained alongside other types of digital evidence. This solution provides for the efficient search and retrieval of evidence during investigations and court proceedings.
