

LGBTQ Quality of Life Advisory Commission MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING Monday, June 18, 2018

The LGBTQ Quality of Life Advisory Commission convened in a regular meeting on Monday, June 18, 2018, in City Hall Room 2005, 301 West Second Street, in Austin, Texas.

1. PUBLIC COMMUNICATION: GENERAL

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The meeting minutes of May 30, 2018, were approved unanimously on a 8-0 vote

3. NEW BUSINESS

a. Intergovernmental Relations Officer Brie Franco made a presentation to the commission on topics that will be of interest during the 2019 session of the Texas Legislature.

b. The commission held elections for officers. Skidmore made a motion to elect Martinez as chair, seconded by Gonzales. The motion to elect Martinez to chair was approved on an 8-0 vote. Currette made a motion to elect Azhar as vice chair, seconded by Wollerson. The motion to elect Azhar to vice chair was approved on a 8-0 vote.

c. The commission discussed a process for recruiting and screening applicants for a vacant at-large position.

d. The commission discussed a process for nominating individuals to receive a volunteer recognition award. Each commission member will recommend a community member to choose the recipient.

e. Clayton Gibson of QWELL presented ideas for an LGBTQ community center that would serve residents in each Council district.

f. The commission discussed participating in Austin Pride events during the month of August. Commissioner Curry agreed to bring back ideas during the July meeting.
