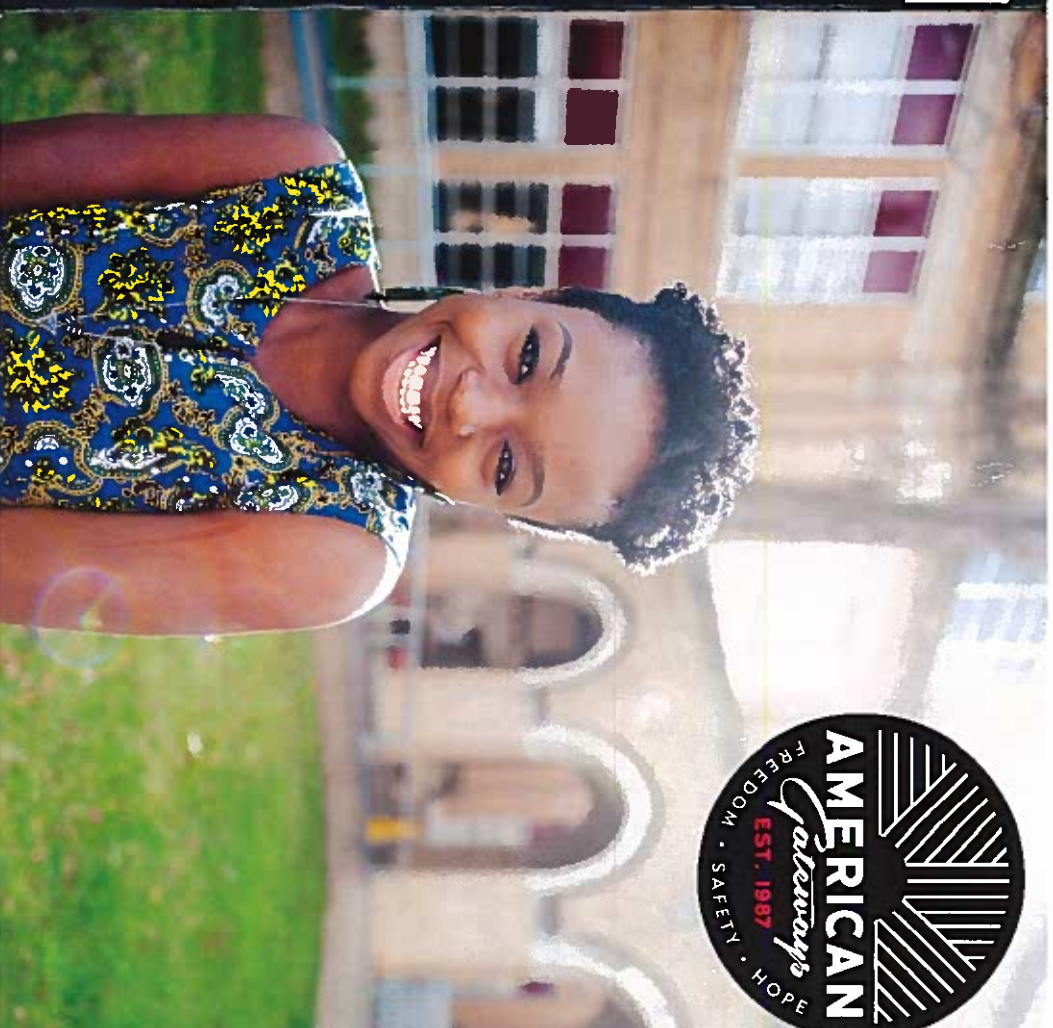

Founded as the Political Asylum Project of Austin (PAPA) in 1987, we began as a dedicated group of volunteers working to serve increasing number of refugees fleeing war in Central America. Since then we have grown to provide a broad range of immigration legal services to low-income individuals and families throughout the region.

### OUR MISSION
