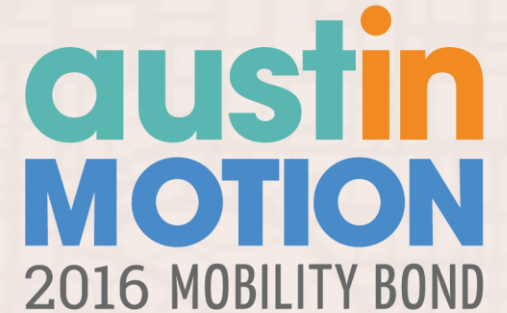


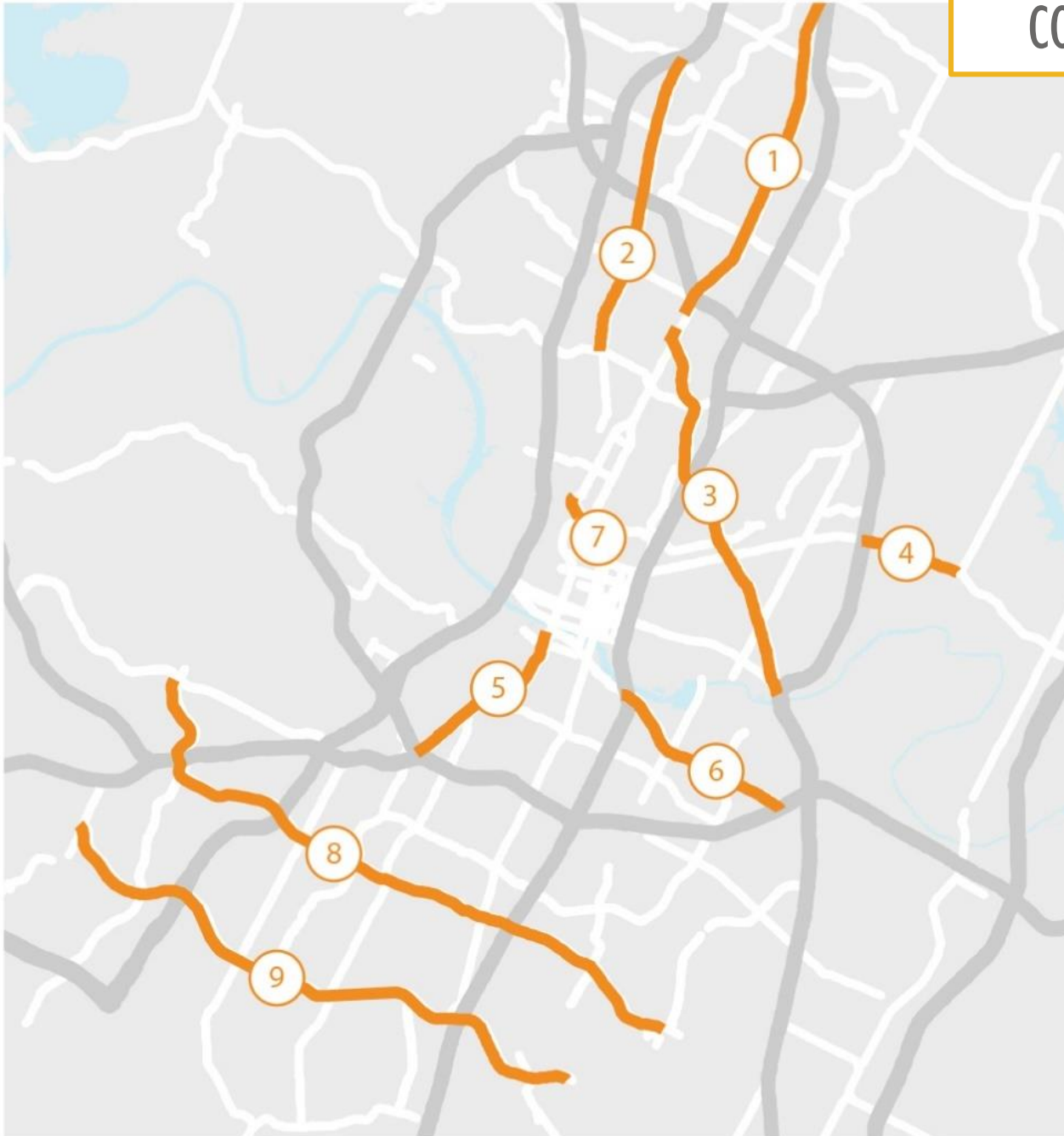

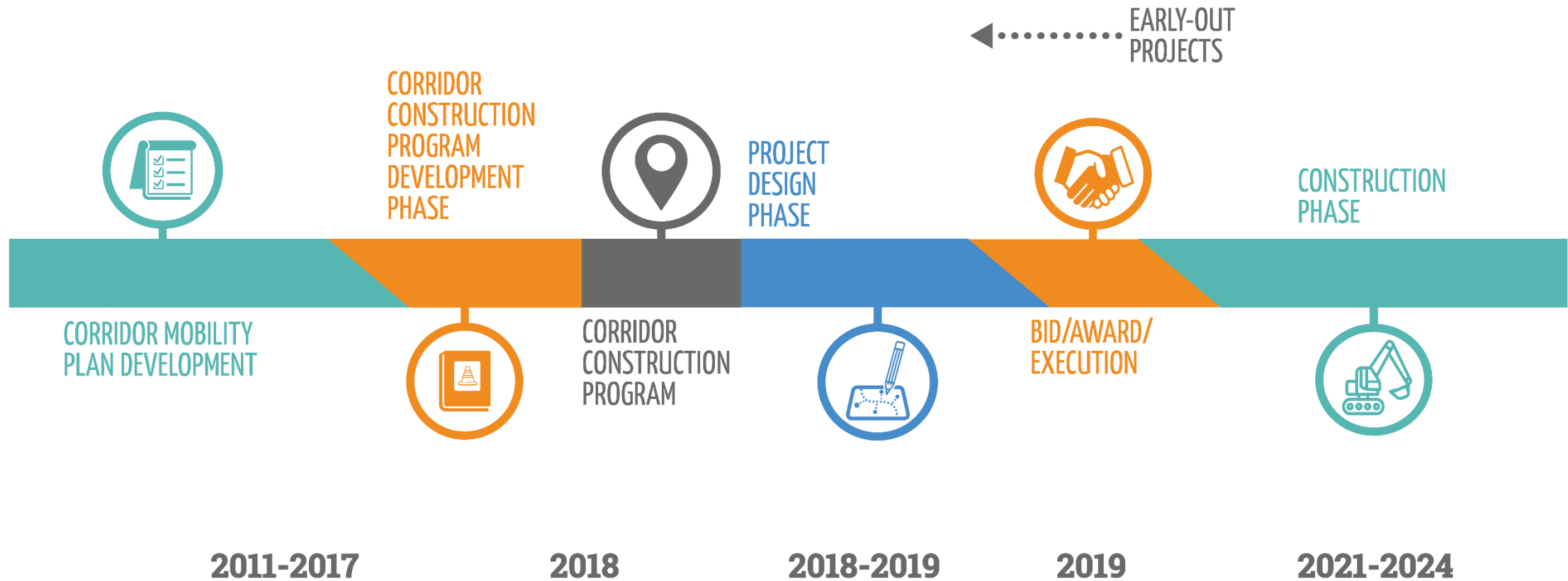


## CORRIDOR CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

- ① North Lamar Boulevard  
(US Hwy. 183 to Howard Lane)
- ② Burnet Road (Koenig Lane to MoPac Expressway)
- ③ Airport Boulevard  
(North Lamar Boulevard to US Hwy. 183)
- ④ East MLK Jr. Boulevard/FM 969  
(US Hwy. 183 to Decker Lane)
- ⑤ South Lamar Boulevard  
(Riverside Drive to Ben White Boulevard/  
US Hwy. 290 West)
- ⑥ East Riverside Drive (I-35 to SH 71)
- ⑦ Guadalupe Street  
(MLK Jr. Boulevard to W. 29th Street)\*
- ⑧ William Cannon Drive  
(Southwest Parkway to McKinney Falls Parkway)\*
- ⑨ Slaughter Lane (FM 1826 to Vertex Road)\*

# NEAR-TERM DESIGN ACTIVITIES

## PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING



- Conduct land surveys to identify property lines, trees, topography
- Geotechnical boring
- Public outreach and engagement
- Refine cost estimates, seek budget efficiencies
- Continue analyzing “realities of implementation” like utility impacts, agency coordination, and geographic dispersion
- Refine project design and prep for full design

## LANGUAGE ACCESS

Corridor	Average % of households in area that are Spanish speaking
Airport Boulevard	29%
Burnet Road	15%
East MLK Jr. Boulevard/ FM 969	43%
East Riverside Drive	37%
Guadalupe Street	9%
North Lamar Boulevard	27%
Slaughter Lane	31%
South Lamar Boulevard	17%
William Cannon Drive	32%

All percentages are estimates. Analysis is based on Statistical Atlas, which uses 2010 U.S. Census and American Community Survey estimates.
