5 **WHEREAS**, the Fire Fighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical
6 Services Personnel Civil Service Commission has been established to ensure general
7 compliance with applicable provisions of Chapter 143 of the Texas Local
8 Government Code, the local Civil Service Rules established by the Commission, and
9 any current agreements between the City of Austin and associations representing
10 firefighters, police officers, and emergency medical services personnel.

11 **WHEREAS**, the Commission may take action on matters related to
12 promotion, appeals of promotional exams, suspension and termination as well as
13 other matters regarding firefighters, police officers and emergency medical services
14 personnel in accordance with the above-mentioned statutes, rules and agreements;
15 and

16 **WHEREAS**, Chapter 143.006 of the Texas Local Government Code provides
17 that the City Manager will appoint three Commissioners for staggered terms, and
18 that the appointment must be confirmed by the City Council; and

19 **WHEREAS**, if a vacancy occurs, the City Manager shall appoint a person to
20 serve for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original
21 appointment; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Commissioner Andrew Harris resigned from the Fire Fighters',
23 Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel Civil Service
24 Commission on July 2, 2018. His unexpired term ends on December 6, 2019; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the City Manager has appointed Mr. Ronald Morgan to fill the
26 vacancy on the Commission created by Commissioner Harris' resignation. Mr.

27 Morgan was appointed to serve the unexpired term ending December 6, 2019. Mr.
28 Morgan meets the statutory prerequisites for appointment to this position; and

29 **WHEREAS**, a vacancy will exist for the Firefighters', Police Officers' and
30 Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission at the
31 expiration of Commissioner Eyna Canales-Zarate's current term on October 31,
32 2018; and

33 **WHEREAS**, the City Manager reappointed Eyna Canales-Zarate to another
34 three-year term, expiring October 31, 2021. Ms. Canales-Zarate meets the statutory
35 prerequisites for appointment.

36 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE**
37 **CITY OF AUSTIN:**

38 The City Council confirms the City Manager's appointment of Ronald
39 Morgan to the Fire Fighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services
40 Personnel Civil Service Commission for the unexpired term ending on December 6,
41 2019.

42 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

43 The City Council confirms the City Manager's reappointment of Eyna
44 Canales-Zarate to the Fire Fighter's, Police Officers' and Emergency Medical
45 Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission for another term that begins on
46 November 1, 2018 and expires on October 31, 2021.
