#### 3. APPROVAL OF JULY 2018 MEETING MINUTES

#### 5. ITEMS FROM STAFF AND BAC

# A. Dockless Mobility Program Update and Discussion – Briefing and Possible Action

Jacob Culberson, Mobility Services Division Manager, Austin Transportation Department (ATD), and Jason JonMichael, Assistant Director, Smart Mobility, ATD, gave a <u>presentation</u> on the <u>Dockless Mobility Program</u> and the upcoming process for establishing a Final Rule governing dockless mobility services in the City of Austin. No action taken.

# B. Recommendation Regarding Bicycle Parking – Discussion and Possible Action

Raquel Ortega presented draft recommendation language to the BAC which read as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BAC requests a written response from city staff within 30 days to be followed by a briefing to the full BAC at the earliest possible date:

- Advise who is currently responsible for collecting and administering the Bicycle Parking Fund;
- Advise of the current balance of the Bicycle Parking Fund;
- Advise whether the program described on the City of Austin Bicycle Parking webpage derives funds from the Bicycle Parking Fund;
- Report the cumulative total amount of money that has been collected from businesses in lieu of meeting bicycle parking minimums;
- Report whether or not bicycle parking has been built at the addresses at which the funds were encumbered as well as the date which money collected was or must be returned;
- Advise of the "grandfathered" cutoff date for current bicycle parking requirements;
- Advise how existing bicycle parking requirements are incorporated into the infrastructure permitting and code enforcement process, as well as who is the responsible party for ensuring compliance;
- Advise what barriers, if any, exist in enforcing compliance with bicycle parking requirements;
- Advise what current training for city staff exists for bicycle parking requirement permitting and enforcement.

**Action taken**: a motion to approve the <u>recommendation</u> was adopted on Ortega motion, Heinen second on a 7-0 vote with Louviere-Ligons and Lentz absent.

# C. Zach Scott Street (Airport Boulevard to Berkman Drive) and Schieffer Avenue (Vineland Drive to Airport Boulevard) – Briefing and Possible Action

Mike Schofield, Engineer, ATD and Neil Quarles, Graduate Engineer, ATD, gave a <u>presentation</u> on <u>proposed improvements</u> to Zach Scott Street from Airport Boulevard to Berkman Drive and Schieffer Avenue from Vineland Drive to Airport Boulevard.

BAC members collaborated to draft recommendation language which, after debate and amendment, read as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BAC supports City staff's original proposed design for Zach Scott Street (Airport Boulevard to Berkman Drive) and Schieffer Avenue (Vineland Drive to Airport Boulevard) as presented at an August 8, 2018 open house.

**Action taken**: a motion to approve the <u>recommendation</u> was adopted on Merlino motion, Eden second on a 7-0 vote with Louviere-Ligons and Lentz absent.
