

FY19 Proposed Budget Overview


- Total Budget of \$113.6M


Sources of Funding

Notable Changes from FY18

- \$262,470 increase in immunizations grant support
- Personnel-related increase totaling \$2M (Insurance, wages and other personnel-related costs)
- Transfer of an IT Application Analyst from Animal Services
- Transfer of contract funding from Austin Energy to support Sickle Cell services and African American Youth Harvest
- Conversion of Day Labor temporary position to full-time
