| PART 1. City Code Chapter 4-18 (<i>General Permitting Standards</i>) is amended to add a new Article 2 to read as follows: |
| ARTICLE 2. ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS |
| § 4-18-20 REGISTRATION REQUIRED. |
| (A) Before a person may perform or offer to preform electrical contracting within the City, the person shall register with the City. |
| (B) A term defined in Article 4 (<i>Electrical Code</i>) of Chapter 25-12 (<i>Technical Codes</i>) has the same meaning in this article. |
| (C) In this article, registrant means a person who registers with the City to perform of offer to perform electrical contracting. |
| § 4-18-21 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO REGISTER. |
| (A) A registrant must be licensed as an electrical contractor pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Texas Occupations Code and Chapter 73 in Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code to register. |
| (B) A registrant shall designate an electrician of record who must be a licensed master electrician. |
| (C) The electrician of record: |
| (1) may be the same as the registrant; |
| (2) may not be designated as the electrician of record for more than one electrical contractor business; and |
| (3) shall appear in person when the electrical contractor business is registered. |
| (D) Not more than three agents may obtain electric permits on behalf of a registrant. |
