

Mechanical and Plumbing Board APPROVED MINUTES

BOARD MEETING September 25, 2018

- 1. CITIZEN COMMUNICATION Bill Weatherly- New Enforcement Director for the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation over Regulatory Program Management. Mr. Weatherly provides to the Board and DSD staff that a maintenance employee is a regular employee that the owner, lessee or management company of the property for where the work is being performed and that it is no public contractor.

AWU is not getting all information from field inspectors and contractors are being held up from attaining meters. AWU is requesting a "re-education" on this process.
