RESOLUTION NO.

3	WHEREAS, the Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Capital
4	Metro) imposes a one cent tax on sales within the corporate limits of the City of
5	Austin (the "City"), and on June 22, 2001, Capital Metro and the City entered into
6	an Interlocal Agreement (the "Interlocal Agreement") whereby Capital Metro
7	would pay to the City its pro rata share of 25% of one cent (or "Quarter Cent") of
8	Capital Metro's sales tax from the years 2001-2004 to carry out various approved
9	transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement provides that each project must be
located in the Capital Metro service area, and that each project must meet one or
more of the following criteria:

- 13 1. Enhances regional mobility
- 14 2. Supports public transit

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- 15 3. Provides leverage for federal or private funds
- 16 4. Adds to an existing program
- 17 5. Expedites a critical mobility project; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the above criteria, on June 18, 2015, Council passed
Resolution No. 20150618-093 directing the City Manager to identify Quarter Centeligible projects that also address the following purposes:

- transportation safety;
- improved access to schools;
- new traffic signals;
- existing infrastructure needs;
- traffic calming;
- improved access to transit; and

other transportation/mobility needs as outlined in the Interlocal Agreement;
and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2015, Council passed Resolution No.
20151217-076, dividing up the remaining Quarter Cent Fund balance (\$21.8
million) such that each Council District received \$1.9 million, and the Mayor
received \$2.8 million for citywide projects; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2016, Council passed Resolution No. 20160128050 that adopted a list of district-specific projects approved for Quarter Cent
funding (the "2016 Quarter Cent Project List"); and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2018, Council passed Resolution No. 20180830063 that adopted a newly updated list of Quarter Cent projects, which superseded
the 2016 Quarter Cent Project List; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2018, Council passed Resolution No.
20180920-028 that adopted a newly updated list of Quarter Cent projects, which
superseded the August 30, 2018 Quarter Cent Project List; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A (attached) is a newly updated list of district-specific projects recommended for Quarter Cent funding. These projects meet the criteria outlined in the Interlocal Agreement with Capital Metro and address the purposes outlined in Council's June 2015 resolution. In addition, staff has reviewed these projects, provided cost estimates for the work, and determined them to be feasible projects and

WHEREAS, Exhibit B (attached) lists projects, if any, that had been intended
for Quarter Cent funding and implementation, but that are now recommended for
removal from consideration due to feasibility or other issues; and

51 WHEREAS, Exhibit C (attached) incorporates the new projects recommended 52 for Quarter Cent funding, as well as Quarter Cent projects currently underway, on 53 hold, or complete, and excludes any projects recommended for removal from 54 consideration, NOW, THEREFORE,

55 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

- 1. The projects listed in the attached Exhibit A- new projects eligible for Quarter Cent funding- are added to the Quarter Cent Project List.
- 2. The projects listed in the attached Exhibit B- projects no longer considered
 appropriate for the Quarter Cent program due to feasibility or other issuesare removed from the Quarter Cent Project List and considered projects no
 longer approved for Quarter Cent funding. If no projects are recommended
 for removal at this time, the Exhibit B will be marked as "Intentionally Left
 Blank."
- 64 3. Exhibit C, which lists the new projects added under No. 1, none of the
 65 projects removed under No. 2, and includes the previously approved projects
 66 that are currently underway, on hold, or completed- is adopted as the new
 67 Quarter Cent Projects List and supersedes previous Quarter Cent Project
 68 Lists.
