The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) offers a Community Partner Program, through which eligible entities can provide citizens with online community-based application assistance for the

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, Medicaid, Long-term Care Services, and the Children's Health Insurance Program.

Austin Public Health (APH) proposes to enter into an interlocal agreement with HHSC to provide online application assistance to citizens at APH's neighborhood centers. The neighborhood centers currently provide basic needs-services to citizens, including the provision of emergency food, case management, and preventive health services. Participation in the HHSC Community Partner program will enable APH to reduce barriers to enrollment in SNAP and other HHSC benefit programs.
