PART 5. The candidates elected at the November 6, 2018 general election and the December 11, 2018 runoff election shall take the oath of office on January 7, 2019, and begin their tenure once qualified.

PART 6. The Council finds that, because of the curtailed period for a runoff election and the desire of the Council to provide an opportunity for early voting, there is a need to immediately begin required preparations for this election. Such need constitutes an emergency, and the Council declares that an emergency exists. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare.
