D. ITEMS FOR COMMISSION'S REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION FOR APPROVAL TO CITY COUNCIL

- 1. Recommend approval to award and execute a multi-term contract with **Firetron, Inc**., to provide preventative maintenance, monitoring, testing, and repair services for a Notifier fire panel, for up to five years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$500,000. Item passed unanimously on Commissioner Maia's motion and Commissioner Turrieta's second on a 6-0 vote with Commissioners Bell, Schmitt, Penn, Parton and Ho absent.

Recommend approval to award and execute a construction contract with **Matous Construction, LTD**., for the Hornsby Bend Side Stream Treatment Plant (SSTP) Relief project in the amount of \$12,604,000 plus a \$1,260,400 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$13,864,400. (ETJ). **Item passed unanimously on Commissioner Michel's motion and Commissioner Castleberry's second on a 6-0 vote with Commissioners Bell, Schmitt, Penn, Parton and Ho absent.**
- 4. Recommend approval of a resolution consenting to the annexation by Lazy Nine Municipal Utility District 1A of approximately 124 acres within the City of Austin's extraterritorial jurisdiction. This action concerns land located within the Barton Springs Zone. Item passed unanimously on Commissioner Maia's motion and Commissioner Turrieta's second on a 6-0 vote with Commissioners Bell, Schmitt, Penn, Parton and Ho absent.
