ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Texas General Land Office Disaster Recovery program provides grants to organizations to help them recover from and prepare for natural disasters. During the 2015 flooding, radio communications hampered the response of law enforcement, fire and ems responders to residents requests for assistance. An analysis of the radio system showed that adding two radio tower sites in southeast Austin and Travis County would provide major improvements in radio communications during natural disaster events.

City of Austin, acting as managing partner for the Greater Austin/Travis County Regional Radio System (GATRRS) applied to the Texas General Land Office for a Disaster Recovery Gant to improve radio communications in southeast Austin and Travis County for law enforcement, fire, and ems responders. Texas GO has awarded \$4,860,509 to City of Austin for improving radio communications in southeast Austin and Travis County.
