

1 **RESOLUTION NO.**

2 **WHEREAS**, Chapter 372 of the Texas Local Government Code (the “Act”)
3 authorizes the creation of a public improvement district (“PID”) by a city or county;
4 and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Act provides that when a county establishes a PID within a
6 city’s corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction, the city may, within 30 days of
7 the county’s approval of the PID, object to its establishment; and

8 **WHEREAS**, on February 12, 2019, Travis County approved the creation of
9 the Velocity Crossing PID, located in the City of Austin’s extraterritorial
10 jurisdiction, which triggered the 30-day statutory period (ending on March 14, 2019)
11 during which the City may object to the PID’s creation; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Velocity Crossing PID is the second PID created by Travis
13 County that is located in the City’s full-purpose annexed jurisdiction; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Velocity Crossing PID is located in the City’s Desired
15 Development Zone, and its development plan indicates that it will increase
16 commercial development in the eastern part of the City, **NOW, THEREFORE,**

17 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

18 The City Council _____ (**FILL IN THE BLANK WITH “does” or**
19 **“does not”**) object to creation of the Velocity Crossing PID.
