 - a. Support legislation that empowers greater local control of how the City uses local hotel occupancy taxes, including expanding allowable uses in Austin to spending on homelessness, parks, <u>watershed protection and preservation</u> <u>projects</u>, arts and public safety.
 - b. Work with other large Texas municipalities to support legislation to expand the allowable uses of local hotel occupancy taxes.
