## Item 4

Texas Commission on Environmental Quality rules, found in Title 30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 288, require retail and wholesale water providers to develop water conservation plans and also to update these plans at least every five years. The Utility Profile & Water Conservation Plan for Municipal and Wholesale Water Use provides an overview of current water conservation initiatives and includes goals to reduce peak day and total average demand and promote the use of conservation and reuse measures to extend the City's water supply.

This Utility Profile & Water Conservation Plan for Municipal and Wholesale Water Use updates the previously adopted 2014 Utility Profile & Water Conservation Plan for Municipal and Wholesale Water Use and fulfills TCEQ requirements under 30 TAC §288.2 and §288.5. Changes from the previous plan:

- Incorporates information and strategies from the Water Forward integrated water resources plan adopted by City Council in 2018
- Updates conservation and water loss goals to align with Water Forward savings estimates
- Updates data on treatment capacity, service area population, and municipal and wholesale water usage to reflect current conditions.
