### **Additional Backup Information:**

This agenda item is to conduct a public hearing to consider approval of an agreement amending previous agreements between the City of Austin and the Austin Independent School District ("AISD") for the primary purpose of facilitating the expansion and redevelopment of Bowie High School. The agreement will allow impervious cover transfers between certain schools in the Barton Springs Zone, including Bowie High School, and establish an ongoing accounting system to track impervious cover transfers between certain schools within the Barton Springs Zone. The overall allowable impervious cover available to AISD within the Barton Springs Zone will remain unchanged as a result of this agreement, and no other development terms outlined in existing agreements with AISD are proposed to be modified.
