6	1.	Resolution No. 20180911-AFHC-002 is repealed and replaced by this resolution.
7	2.	The Board of Directors of the Austin Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC)
8		approves the General Obligation Capital Improvement Budget (Capital Budget)
9		for the Fiscal Year 2018-2019, beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September
10		30, 2019, attached to this resolution.
11	3.	Except as provided in Paragraph 3, the general manager may authorize the use of
12		funds:
13		(a) in the Capital Budget; and
14		(b) remaining unspent at the close of Fiscal Year 2017-2018 associated with
15		the Bond Program.
16	4. ′	The general manager may only authorize the use of funds if:
17		(a) the amounts are available and are used for the programs and purposes in the
18		Capital Budget;
19		(b) the activity for which funds are spent is eligible under a Bond Program;
20		(c) current AHFC Program Guidelines permit the use; and
21		(d) the general counsel approves the form of the contract.
22	5. ′	The general manager must obtain Board approval to authorize:

23		(a) a contract expenditure amount greater than \$300,000;
24		(b) acquisition of an interest in real estate valued at more than \$250,000; and
25		(c) sale or transfer of an interest in real estate with an appraised fair market
26		value exceeding \$250,000.
27	6.	The general manager may promulgate and amend the AHFC Program Guidelines
28		related to programs authorized under the Capital Budget. Before the effective date
29		of the AHFC Program Guidelines, the general manager may not authorize the use
30		of funds for a housing program under the Capital Budget that is:
31		(a) approved as a community development program under Texas Local
32		Government Code Chapter 373; and
33		(b) administered or managed by AHFC under its contract with the City related
34		to bond funding.
35	7.	The general manager may designate a person to act on his behalf to implement the
36		actions approved by this resolution.
