## MOTION SHEET

I move to amend the Mobility Outcome strategies and metrics for Austin Strategic Direction 2023 as follows:

1. **Amend Strategy 3 to read as follows:**

"Encourage use of sustainable modes of transportation and discourage driving alone and single-purpose trips citywide to maximize the use of our transportation network. Lead by example as an employer in incentivizing, offering, promoting, and implementing mobility options for all City employees, people doing business with the City, and people participating in public input opportunities."

2. **Amend Strategy 5 to read as follows:**

"Coordinate with Capital Metro, Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority, Texas Department of Transportation, Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization, Capital Area Council of Governments, school districts, and other agencies to maximize the person-carrying capacity of the transportation network."

3. **Add Strategy 14 to read as follows:**

"Identify and implement land use policies that support a shift towards a more-sustainable mode share."

4. **Amend Metric C3 to read as follows:**

"Number of ~~projects and emerging mobility pilot~~ projects initiated and successfully completed in Innovation Zones"

5. **Add Metric C7 to read as follows:**

"Percent of people working in Austin that commute in for work (i.e. do not live in Austin)"

6. **Amend Metric D3 to read as follows:**

"Percentage of fatalities and serious injuries reduced ~~as a result of following~~ street design/infrastructure projects on the High-Injury Network"

7. **Add Metric D5 to read as follows:**

"Number and percent of customer service requests for the removal of highly hazardous blockages (e.g. debris, vegetation, construction-related, vehicular, or any other blockages) of bike facilities and sidewalks resolved within 72 hours."

8. **Add Metric D6 to read as follows:**

"Number and percent of Safe Routes to Schools infrastructure projects at each of the following stages: Recommended (High or Very High Benefit), Planned/Funded, Design, Construction, Completed"
