WHEREAS, in 2018, Master Sgt. Jonathan J. Dunbar was killed by an improvised explosive device detonated near his patrol in Manbij, Syria; and

WHEREAS, Dunbar was a member of the U.S. Army Special Operations Command in Fort Bragg, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Dunbar grew up in North Austin and was a 1999 graduate of John B. Connally High School in Austin, located on North Lamar Boulevard within the Pflugerville Independent School District; and

WHEREAS, State Sen. Kirk Watson and State Rep. Gina Hinojosa are sponsors of Senate Bill 1134 and House Bill 2506, which would designate a portion of Farm-to-Market Road 734 (Parmer Lane), between Metric Boulevard and Lamar Boulevard, as Jonathan J. Dunbar Memorial Parkway; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council supports the passage of Senate Bill 1134 and House Bill 2506 and directs the City Manager to provide copies of this resolution to the legislators who comprise the Austin and Travis County delegations.
