
# Guadalupe St. & Lavaca St. Transit Improvements

## **Existing Conditions**

- Austin Transportation, Capital Metro and the Corridor Program Office are collaborating to improve Lavaca Street and Guadalupe Street, one of the highest-volume corridors in the Capital Metro system.
- Currently, northbound buses travel along Lavaca Street, and turn right or left at Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.
- Left-hand turns are cumbersome at Lavaca Street/Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, particularly during peak hours.
- Despite attempts to improve operations with a transit-priority lane, bus signal, and other components, bus operations continue to experience delay.









### **Planned Improvements**

- To address these challenges, Austin
   Transportation and Capital Metro will

   implement routing and infrastructure
   improvements this year, including a contraflow
   lane on Guadalupe Street between 18th
   Street and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard
- These improvements are included in the Corridor Program Office's City Councilapproved Corridor Construction Program, and are being expedited and constructed this year as a "first out" project






Guadalupe St. & Lavaca St. Transit Improvements
