Additional Backup Information:

This action will authorize the addition of one grant funded position to serve as the site coordinator for the City of Austin Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) grant program. The site coordinator position is a grant requirement and was originally included in the two active grants as a temporary employee. The department has been unable to hire a qualified candidate to oversee the program as a temporary employee.

Converting this temporary grant position to a full-time grant position enhances the opportunity for the City to hire and retain a coordinator for the duration of the project, which is currently funded through September 30, 2021. The site coordinator, in cooperation with other key personnel and stakeholders, is responsible for:

- Acting as the single point of contact (SPOC) for the Austin site
- Drafting performance metrics and quarterly reporting
- Consulting with SAKI collaborations: SARRT and ISAT
- Coordinating SAKI activities
- Preparing executive-level briefings to include SAKI successes, challenges, assessment findings and recommendations
- Assisting with structuring and institutionalizing systems, policies, and protocols developed by the Austin workgroup to address the backlog of SAKs and prevent reoccurrence
