Describe the issue facing your community or stakeholder group. In your role as Commissioner, what have you heard from your community about the issue? (Required)

As redevelopment takes place on Austin's south shore, the community wants community benefits, including: expanded public access to the waterfront and open spaces; pedestrian-friendly, green streetscapes and walkable connections; separated bike lanes and mobility options; and affordable housing opportunity. The consultant services will provide Council with information required to make decisions on implementation that would secure these community benefits.

Note: For example: Availability of affordable housing continues to be a primary concern for our community.

What does the data tell us about the issue? Is there data on who is most impacted by the issue?

The South Central Waterfront Vision Framework Plan, adopted by Council in 2016, was the result of four-years of community engagement. During that planning stage, the City conducted over 30 public events, engaging over 1600 citizens. Increased waterfront connections and park spaces; walkable, green streets; beautiful public spaces; and affordable housing options were the key concerns. Implementing the Plan could capture hundreds-of-millions of dollars to secure these benefits.

Note: For example: There have been many studies done, most recently "Uprooted" from the University of Texas. This research identified 5 factors that make people vulnerable to displacement, and within all 5 of these, people of color are disproportionately represented.

What is your recommendation for addressing this issue? Recommendations should focus on increasing efficiency, effectiveness, and equity. (Required)

Re-hiring the consultants who have worked on the Plan would be a cost-effective and quick way to update the financial information to calibrate potential developer fees & potential tax revenues that could deliver the SCW Plan's community benefits.

Note: For example: In response to feedback from the community, our commission recommends that the City further investigate ways to address limited affordable housing availability, specifically exploring opportunities to increase workforce housing options in our community. The Commission requests a report of findings and an action plan to address this recommendation.
