

Describe the issue facing your community or stakeholder group. In your role as Commissioner, what have you heard from your community about the issue? (Required)

The DACC is an integral part of the continuum of care provided by an array of local non-profits, and substance abuse and mental health providers. The DACC provides much-needed services to individuals experiencing homelessness through the Homeless Outreach Street Team ("HOST") referrals, judicial referrals, and peer referrals. Due to case management capacity, since in FY 2017, the DACC has maintained a waitlist for individuals seeking case management services; that list currently includes 63 individuals. As a result, and the DACC has requested additional resources in order to meet the increasing demand for programs and services to assist Austin's most vulnerable citizens in stabilizing their lives to the benefit of the entire Austin community.

Note: For example: Availability of affordable housing continues to be a primary concern for our community.

What does the data tell us about the issue? Is there data on who is most impacted by the issue?

A large percentage of the cases scheduled by the DACC Case Managers involve defendants who are experiencing homelessness. Since October 1, 2016, \_\_\_\_\_ cases were filed in the DACC. \_\_\_\_ of these cases involved \_\_\_\_\_ defendants experiencing homelessness, \_\_\_\_\_ of all the cases filed. An estimated \_\_\_\_\_ individuals were experiencing homeless across Austin in calendar year 2018, and approximately \_\_\_\_\_ households are known to be homeless and seeking housing at this time—a 5% increase over 2017. Fewer people ended their homelessness in 2018 than in 2017. These statistics show that community programs addressing the needs of individuals experiencing homelessness are running at capacity—demand for these services exceeds the supply.

Note: For example: There have been many studies done, most recently "Uprooted" from the University of Texas. This research identified 5 factors that make people vulnerable to displacement, and within all 5 of these, people of color are disproportionately represented.



We support the DACC's request for additional funds to increase its case management capacity and housing resources to continue providing needed services to its clients and the Downtown Austin Community Court Advisory Board encourages the Austin City Council to allocate funds and explore all available means in order to fund solutions to address homelessness in Austin.

#### Recommendation for FY20 Budget Funding for the Downtown Austin Community Court

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Downtown Austin Community Court (DACC) is to collaboratively address the quality of life issues of all residents in the downtown Austin community through the swift, creative sentencing of public order offenders. The Court seeks to hold people responsible while also offering help to change behavior; and

WHEREAS, DACC Case Management team aims to end homelessness by providing comprehensive, long term services to individuals experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, The Homeless Outreach Street Team or HOST is a new, innovative and collaborative initiative that operates in the Downtown and West Campus area. HOST proactively reaches out to individuals living on the streets to help them connect to the services the need (including through DACC) to get back on their feet and reach their full potential; and

WHEREAS, the DACC is an integral part of the continuum of care provided by an array of local non-profits, and substance abuse and mental health providers. The DACC provides much-needed services to individuals experiencing homelessness through HOST referrals, judicial referrals, and peer referrals; and

WHEREAS, a large percentage of the cases scheduled by	the DACC Case Managers involve defendants
who are experiencing homelessness. In fiscal year 2018,	4,184 cases were filed in the DACC. 1,371 of
these cases involved 431 defendants experiencing homele	essness, 33% of all the cases filed; and

WHEREAS, an estimated	individuals were experiencing homeless across Austin in calendar yea
2018, and approximately	_ households are known to be homeless and seeking housing at thi
time—a 5% increase over 2017;	and

WHEREAS, fewer people ended their homelessness in 2018 than in 2017; and

WHEREAS, these statistics show that community programs addressing the needs of individuals experiencing homelessness are running at capacity—demand for these services exceeds the supply; and

WHEREAS, due to case management capacity, since in FY 2017, the DACC has maintained a waitlist for individuals seeking case management services; that list currently includes 63 individuals; and

WHEREAS, the DACC has requested additional resources in order to meet the increasing demand for programs and services to assist Austin's most vulnerable citizens in stabilizing their lives to the benefit of the entire Austin community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Downtown Austin Community Court Advisory Board wholeheartedly and enthusiastically supports the DACC's request for additional funds to increase its case management capacity and housing resources to continue providing needed services to its clients and the Downtown Austin Community Court Advisory Board encourages the Austin City Council to allocate funds and explore all available means in order to fund solutions to address homelessness in Austin.
