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2018 Community Action Plan

- Met or exceeded all goals except:
 - ❖ **Number of people unemployed and obtained a job**
39 people achieved the outcome (70.91% of goal)
 - ❖ **Number of individuals who improved skills related to the adult role of parent/caregivers**
32 people achieved the outcome (64% of goal)

Demographics

- **1,691** unduplicated persons received direct funded CSBG services.
- **37,183** unduplicated persons received CSBG supported services (no additional demographics gathered).

Successes

- **466 persons avoided eviction.**
 - ❖ Exceeded our goal of 375 persons (124.27% of goal)
- **15 unemployed adults obtained employment with a living wage or higher.**
 - ❖ Exceeded our goal of 10 persons (150% of goal)
- **43 persons transitioned out of poverty**
 - ❖ Met our goal of 43 persons (100% of goal)

Successes (cont.)

- **30,403** persons received food assistance
- **353** persons received rent assistance
- **775 Flu Shots** provided by Public Health Nurses at the Neighborhood Center
- **7,073** persons served received Public Health Nursing services at the Neighborhood Centers

Successes (cont.)

- **669 persons received tax preparation services.**
 - ❖ Partnership with the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP)

Areas for Improvement

- **Sharpen focus on outreach to low-income individuals and families**
- **Continue to explore options for service expansion to underserved areas**
- **Continue to strengthen partnerships that help remove barriers to self-sufficiency**
