Prevent illness, injury, and disease


Protect the community from

- Total Budget of \$115 million

 - -Grants Budget of \$34.6 M
- FTEs
 - -285.5 general fund
 - -243 grant funded

- Community Services: Neighborhood Services, Family Health, Day Labor and WIC

 Chronic Disease, Injury Prevention,
 Communicable Disease and Immunizations
- Environmental Health Services: Inspection Services, Environmental Rodent Control, One Stop Shop
