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#### Additional Backup Information:

Pursuant to state statute, the City is required to obtain approval from Council for any individual job order assignment that exceeds \$500,000. This request is for Council's authorization to negotiate and execute a Job Order Assignment in accordance with the existing Job Order Contract in an amount not-to-exceed \$600,000.

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With the recent residential growth of the University Hills neighborhood, the adjacent Colony Park area and other nearby Eastside communities, the existing parking lot at the University Hills Branch Library has proven to be completely inadequate to accommodate the number of citizens seeking to acquire library services at this branch location. As there is no street parking along this busy stretch of Loyola Street between Manor Road, a major arterial street, and United States Highway 183, the expansion of this parking lot is driven by a concern for public safety and stands as the most pressing project the Library Department currently possesses.

This project will provide additional needed parking at the University Hills Branch Library in East Austin, 4721 Loyola Ln, 78723. The Library was originally constructed in 1985, and the current parking lot has become inadequate for the use the growing community. The project work will include the construction of 29 new parking lot spaces on the north side of the library. Four spaces will be removed from the existing lot for connection of existing structures and pavement, installation of erosion/sedimentation controls, and tree protection fencing.

The parking lot expansion will provide additional ADA parking spaces, provide adequate LED lighting, parking lot signage, and safety fencing. The construction will include pervious pavement of 29 parking spaces to meet water quality drainage requirements, as well as the construction of a water quality pond, construction of associated walkways, installation of landscaping, and construction of an additional driveway.

This project is located within zip code 78723 (District 1).
