# Posting Language

Set a public hearing to consider a resolution amending the Regulating Plan for the North Burnet Gateway Zoning District to allow for the requirement for the building façade to be stepped back 30 feet from the ground level façade line (Section 4.2, Figure 4-1 of the North Burnet Gateway Regulating Plan) to be eligible for Alternative Equivalent Compliance. 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# Additional Backup Information:

The proposed change will amend the North Burnet Gateway Regulating Plan to allow alternative equivalent compliance for the requirement for street facing facades to be set back 30 feet at the 6<sup>th</sup> floor and above. The proposed change will also bring the North Burnet Gateway Regulating Plan into greater alignment with the requirements of the East Riverside Corridor Regulating Plan, which will improve the administration of the plan.

The proposed change will allow for greater architectural creativity and context-sensitive design in meeting the intent of the code, which is to create a human-scaled pedestrian environment.
