## Recommendation

With the alarming increase in unsheltered homelessness throughout the city and current lack of resources for the unsheltered, the Downtown Commission recommends City Council take the following actions:

- 1. Ensure that the City Manager follows through on the Council's January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019 Resolution No. 20190131-078to open and operate a new pilot shelter by September 30, 2019.
- 2. Open at least two additional shelters in key locations in the city by September 30, 2020. Explore all funding sources including public/private partnerships.
- 3. Create a comprehensive data base with real-time information on shelter and homeless navigation services by November 2019 and immediately focus outreach and service resources (i.e. HOST/Integral Care) to effectively address the needs of people who are homeless and experiencing substance use and behavioral health disorders.
- 4. Based on the April 18, 2019 Echo recommendation endorsed by City Council, our goals for shelters is to move people through the system. Not to provide a dead end.
- 5. Upgrade the Homeless Strategy Officer position that was recently created to be a direct report to the City Manager.
