Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract with Navigant Consulting Inc., or one of the other qualified offerors to Request for Proposals (RFP) 1100 EAL3002, to provide regulatory consulting services in an amount not to exceed \$99,000.

For the services required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established).

Council Committee, Boards and Commission Action:

May 13, 2019 - Recommended by the Electric Utility Commission on an 8-0 vote, with Commissioner Weldon off the dais and Commissioners Hadden and Stone absent.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide regulatory consulting services for Austin Energy including public outreach meetings, reporting, analysis, and recommendations to accomplish identified tasks. On August 29, 2016 City Council

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signed Ordinance No. 20160829-004, which included a Joint Recommendation that identified research items to address prior to the next rate case. The contractor will prepare studies on the rate structure for Secondary Voltage Service 1 (demand less than 10 kilowatt) including the appropriateness of the non-demand threshold. The contractor will also study the characteristics and determinants of non-residential customers' monthly peak demand, including load profile analysis, peak usage sensitivity to weather inputs, and the extent to which individual customer peaks are coincident with system peaks of Austin Energy and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas.

This is a new contract. An evaluation team with expertise in this area evaluated the offers and scored Navigant Consulting Inc. as the best to provide these services based on concept and solution, personnel qualifications, price, demonstrated applicable experience, local business preference, and service-disabled veteran business enterprise.

This request allows for the development of a contract with a qualified offeror selected by Council. If the City is unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory contract with the selected offeror, negotiations will cease with that provider. Staff will return to Council so that another qualified offeror may be selected, authorizing new contract negotiations.
