**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE
CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas, to enact one or more ordinances authorizing the issuance of one or more series of interest bearing certificates of obligation of the City to be entitled "City of Austin, Texas, Certificates of Obligation", for the purpose of paying contractual obligations to be incurred by the City, to-wit, design work and construction of the Waterloo Park Link, along with related infrastructure improvements to effect the connection to Symphony Square, restoration of the creek and adjacent open space; Pool improvements and renovation of the Govalle and Shipe Pools and related infrastructure; and the payment of fiscal, engineering and legal fees incurred in connection with these projects. The Certificates of Obligation shall bear interest at a rate or rates, not to exceed the maximum interest rate allowed by law, and mature no later than 40 years from their date of issuance. The City Council tentatively proposes to enact one or more ordinances authorizing the issuance of the Certificates of Obligation (one or more series) at its regular meeting place located at 301 W. 2nd Street, at a meeting to commence at 10:00 o'clock, a.m., on the 22nd day of August, 2019. The maximum principal amount of Certificates of Obligation indebtedness that may be authorized on said date for such purposes described above is \$21,260,000. The City Council presently proposes to provide for payment of the series (one or more) of Certificates of Obligation from the levy of ad valorem taxes and from a limited pledge (not to exceed \$1,000) of the revenues of the City's solid waste disposal system.
