Council directs the City Manager to place into that Fund the following payments: temporary use of right-of-way fees, alley vacation sales payments, and license agreement payments from development projects within the Rainey Street Historic District and Subdistrict (as shown on the attached Exhibit 1).
17 18 19	PART 3. Council may annually appropriate the Fund for projects with a municipal purpose that are within the area delineated by the boundaries shown on the attached Exhibit 1.
20 21 22	PART 4. As with other City funds, the City Manager will establish controls so that the Fund is used for projects identified during the annual budget process and approved by Council in the annual budget or a budget amendment.
