






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Rebates and Incentives Budget, FY19 YTD












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


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Total Peak Water Savings, Gallons Per Day (GPD)






WATER USE - GALLONS PER CAPITA PER DAY (GPCD)



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Total Cumulative Water Savings Projected for FY 2019







Daily Water Usage June 2019








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Lakes Buchanan and Travis **Total Combined Storage Projections**
