Eureka has hired Gehl to develop planning principles and conceptual plans. What is the target date for those deliverables? What is James Lima's role in Eureka's planning process?

Does Eureka have any proposals in the works for which development feasibility is underway or completed? If so, where?

When do you anticipate a plan for restoration of the I. Q. Hurdle House will be presented to the Historic Landmark Commission?

Is Eureka committed to only doing projects that the adjacent community and the URB support?

What is the purpose of the fencing that Eureka has erected along the 1300 block and at the corner of East 12th and Salina Streets?

Is Eureka collaborating with Mission Possible or its leadership to acquire additional property from them or for them, or to plan/develop any projects? If so, where?
